## An Invitation to Planting Hope

Grace and peace to you, God's beloved. I give thanks to God for you, your faithful discipleship and your commitment to leading with love for the world.

Coming up in April, you are going to be invited to consider making a financial gift towards the Saint Paul Area Synod capital campaign.

From the synod's website:

The Planting Hope Campaign expresses our confidence that God is at work in the 107 congregations and mission starts of the Saint Paul Area Synod, and God is at work in the East Metro of the Twin Cities, the territory served by our synod. To date, we have raised more than \$1.4 million that supports these four activity areas:

Invite neighbors into life in Christ Renew the congregations of the synod Raise up the next generations of leaders Invest in a transformative project on the East Side of St. Paul

Thanks to the generosity of congregations and major donors, we rejoice in the successful completion of that fourth item...the transformative project on St. Paul's East Side. At the 2023 Synod Assembly, we presented a \$1 million check to Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota. Those funds were designated for the renovation of Grace Lutheran Church in St. Paul to house LSS' Families Together Eastside Preschool. This therapeutic preschool will be a life-changing resource for children and their families on the East Side of St. Paul when it opens in the fall of 2024.

As of early 2024, we are now moving into the "Planting MORE Hope" phase of the campaign as we focus on two of the other initiatives: Raise up the next generation of leaders and Renew the congregations of the synod.



From my perspective, one of the beautiful things about our church body, the ELCA, is that it reminds us our work is much bigger than just what we do at 1669 Arcade. Through our prayers and generosity we are able to support this larger work that God is doing all around us. Join us as we learn more and consider a generous gift to support this larger work. Thank you to the Endowment Fund and their gift of a matching gift of \$5,000, every gift you give will be doubled!

Colleen Baldrica, author of Tree Spirited Woman:


A story of Spiritual Awakening and Life Enrichment will be at Gustavus on Wednesday, April 24 at 1:00 pm to talk about her book.
